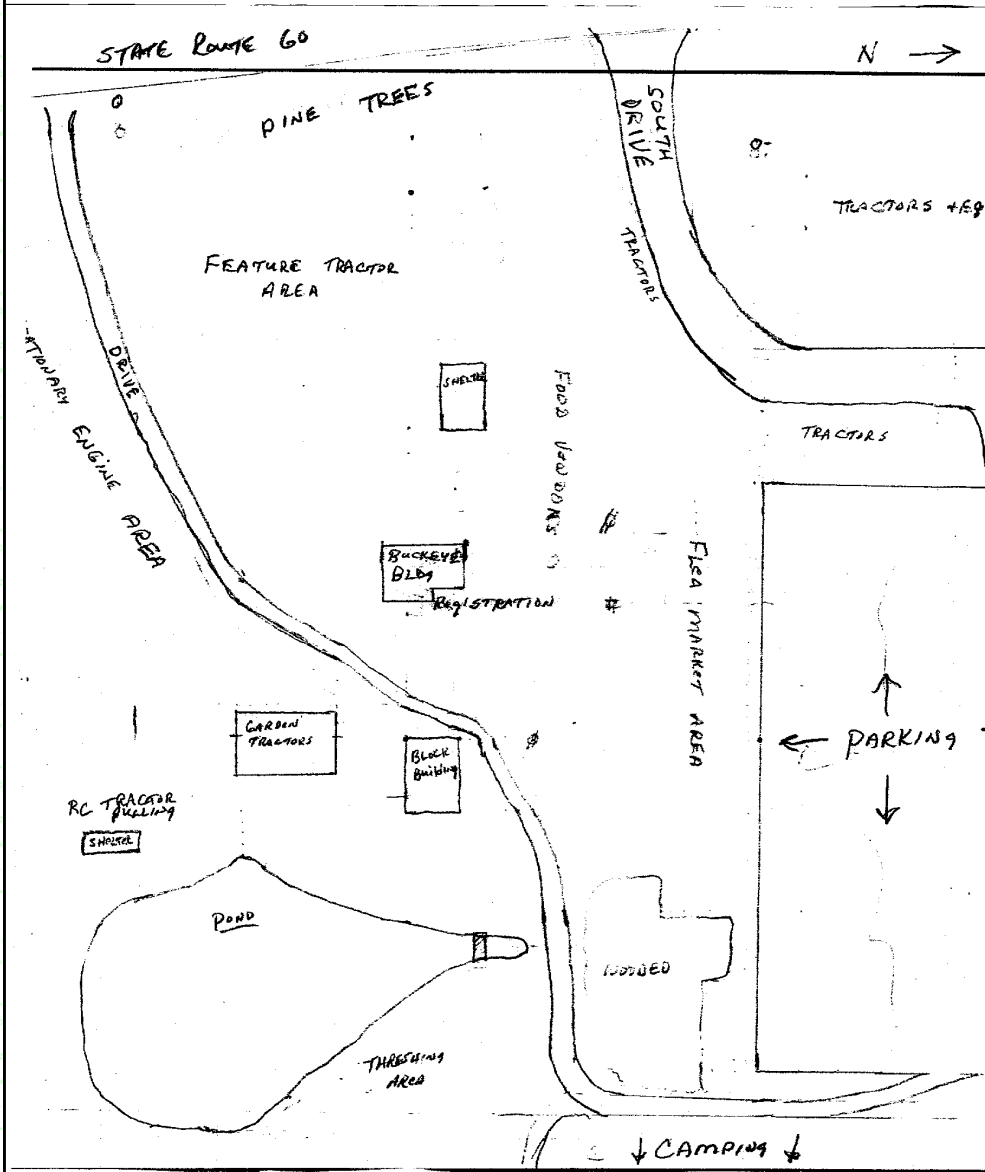

(Zion Hill Rd). Go 2.0 mi.

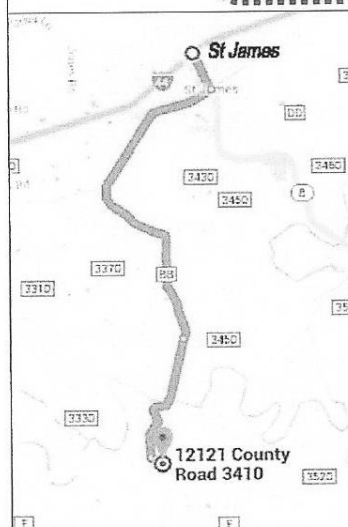

## An activity if in Rushville for the MCA Show

Harry Knight would like to invite members of the Massey Harris Ferguson Club of Ohio while attending the Massey Expo of North America to take a train excursion from Connersville, IN to the historic canal town of Metamora, IN.

The train departs Connersville for the 16 mile trip at 12 noon on Saturday and Sunday and returns at 5 PM with a two hour layover in Metamora. The train can be chartered on other days of the week but would require a coach load of approximately 75 people and would need to be prepaid. The cost for the ride is \$22.00.

There is also a train ride in Metamora which is two miles long and lasts for 30 minutes

and is \$5.00 a person.

The original canal in Metamora has been restored and a canal boat offers a one mile ride. The town also has numerous shops and restaurants.

The railroad operates all historic equipment including first generation diesel engines, the newest of which was manufactured in 1954. The coaches and cabooses were built in the 1920's and 1930's.

Connersville is approximately 15 miles from Rushville and Metamora is about 30 miles.
