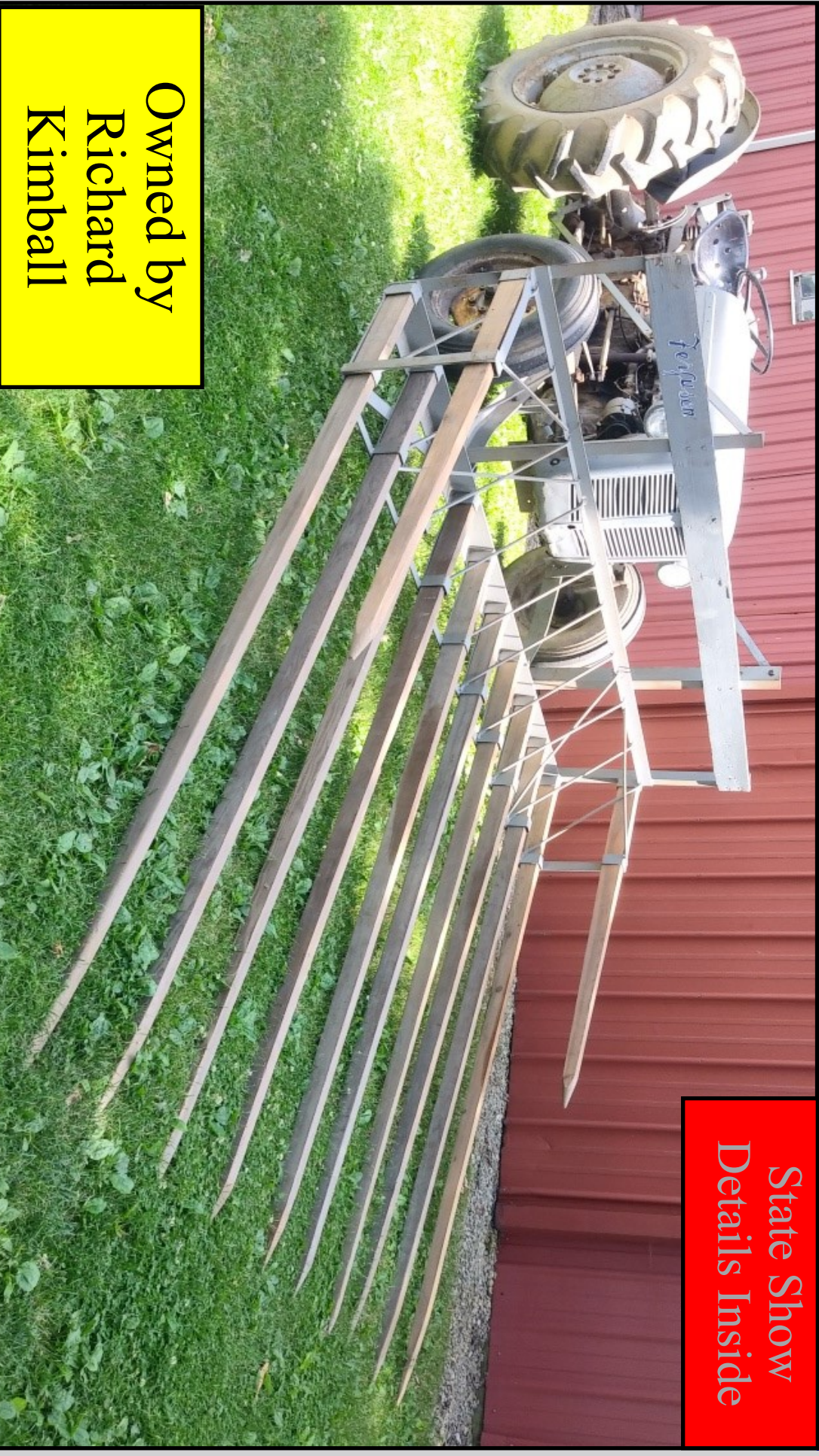

Camping—Primitive Camping is available on the grounds—no reservations required. \$50 for the show; tractor exhibitors free. Open fires/fireworks and Chinese lanterns are prohibited. No electric, water or sewer hook-ups.

Dog Policy—Dogs are not permitted on the show grounds or flea market, but are permitted in the camping areas (located outside of gates) as long as they are pen/cage, or inside your camper or on a leash that does not extend beyond your camping lot.

Massey Tents—Tents will be available for inside displays and vendors. Due to limited space, you must notify a committee member listed below of your intentions **NLT May 1, 2019**. First come, first served basis. Reserve early to guarantee space. Cancel if plans change. You will be allowed to enter thru **Gate #4** to unload in tent but when finished unloading you will have to move your vehicle(s) to the public parking area. There is no parking in/near the feature area.

Canopies/Tents/Registration—Canopies are not allowed over tractors. All tractors are to be unloaded & enter thru **Gate #3** and register at the Tractor Registration area located inside that gate to receive your arm bands for free admission.

All Golf Carts and similar type vehicles—used for transportation of the physically challenged must be registered at **Gate #1** & must provide proof of insurance.

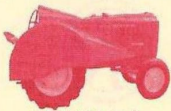
