Find your favorite way to Rushville. Follow IN 3 South out of town, staving right at the Y with US 52 and IN-3, Travel 3 miles South on IN-3 to 350 W. Turn right on 350W and travel.8 miles to a slight left turn onto 200W. The park will be on your right.

From the South or West:

Find your favorite way to Greensburg or Milroy on IN-3. Go North of Milroy on IN-3 for 4.8 miles. Turn left on 350W and travel.8 miles to a slight left turn onto 200W. The park will be on vour right.

IMCA PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGES

In order to align the Indiana Chapter of MCA with the national MCA organization the following changes to the IMCA By-Laws are proposed:

Add: ARTICLE III – MEMBERSHIP

The Indiana Massey Collectors Association (IMCA) offers one type of membership:

Section 1. Family Membership – Upon payment of dues to the Membership Chair of MCA a family membership will provide the opportunity for an individual and his /her spouse to vote on all matters brought before the membership.

ARTICLE III IV - MEETINGS

Section 6. Roberts Rules of Order Revised shall be the procedure of all meetings. Generally accepted business procedures will be followed during all meetings.

ARTICLE VI - OFFICERS

Section 1. There shall be four officers: President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. The officers have all the privileges of a Board member, including the right to vote.

These changes are presented to the membership for consideration and will be acted on at the Spring Meeting of the Indiana Massey Collectors Association on April 12, 2014.

Registration

Record exhibits and exhibitors. Distribute exhibitor ribbons, buttons and parking tags? Distribute gift bags. Provide general information. (Separate pop-up tent?)

Tractor/Equipment/Trailer Parking

Plan any special parking for tractor, implements and equipment displays. Greet visitors. Direct to specific location for their display. Assist with unloading as needed. Ensure equipment is available to unload and load equipment and implements. Provide directions for trailer and vehicle parking. (Need to be at show before, during and after) **MUST KNOW HOW TO SMILE AND BE FRIENDLY**. You are our first impression.

Hospitality

Plan and decorate Hospitality Tent and immediate area. Make available water, cookies, coffee etc. for exhibitors. Provide "Kids Area." Keep area neat and clean. Provide direction and information. Work with Displays & Memorabilia Committee to determine space needs.

Displays & Memorabilia

Determine space and table needs and ensure they are available for exhibitors. Assist exhibitors in unloading and loading.

Camping

Work with Pioneer Club to coordinate spaces needed for exhibitor camping. Greet campers and direct them to appropriate location.

Gift Bags

Solicit items depicting Indiana commodities and other special items that will serve as a welcome to Indiana. Should include Convention & Visitors Bureau information, Indiana and area maps, area tourist information, map to Banquet. Other materials appropriate for our guests.

Chair -

Vendors

Solicit Massey related vendors and provide appropriate display areas for each. Greet and direct vendors to their locations.

Chair -

Auction/Silent Auction?

Plan, organize and conduct the bendfit auction after the Annual Banquet. Solicit items, donations and special items for auction. Provide clerking and ring people to assist. Collect funds and record transactions. Provide thank you notes to donors.

Chair -

Evening Exhibitor Dinners (Thursday & Friday)

Coordinate meal and preparation. Ensure table service, drinks and table coverings are available. Provide servers and assistants. Understand trash disposal. Ensure clean-up crew is available. Serve as greeters to our guests.

Chair -

Photos

Provide candid and exhibit photos of the Exposition to be used for future use. Possibly coordinate group photo of exhibitors.

Chair -

Signage & Advertising

Provide appropriate directional and informational signage. This might include parking, golf cart parking area, announcement signs, recognition signs. This might include banners, etc.

Chair -

Annual Banquet

The banquet is usually the last and most memorable event of the Exposition. Thus the banquet could involve several different sub-committees working together. At this time the Banquet will be held at the Rush County Fairgrounds and will be catered by the Bluebird Restaurant in Morristown. The committee's work will include assisting the caterer with any needs they have including serving, setting up the hall, providing decorations, planning and directing a reservation process and managing tickets, clean-up and trash.




